

# Healthcare Company Case Study





One challenge he saw sitting at the intersection between problems and possibilities was pervasive burnout among frontline healthcare workers. What would happen if he could make it easier to identify distressed team members and to provide proactive intervention that resulted in healthier providers and patients?

Every moment matters in healthcare. Delay can be deadly. That's why vellum was built on the bedrock of taking action - the kind of action that helps frontline teams build trust and cohesion and encourages emotional connections.

Leading teams and pioneering products through the years taught John three core principles that informed his approach to launching vellum:

- The challenge and thrill of CREATING something meaningful.
- The value of CONNECTION for our well-being.





## PASSIONATE. CREATIVE. CAPABLE. ASPIRING.

That's how John describes The Engineered Innovation Group (EIG) after collaborating to create vellum's Minimum Viable Product (MVP). EIG's design made it easier to meet healthcare workers where they are from the bedside to the breakroom - and to understand how they were feeling at any given moment. The resulting "safe space" enables users to pause, label, and share their current emotional state as well as their successes and struggles in less than a minute.

EIG built the solution utilizing:

- Expo managed React Native application
- Firebase authentication
- Google Cloud Platform
- Neo4i
- Express
- NextJs

According to John, the most significant technical challenges EIG helped him overcome were the implementation of Single Sign On (SSO), connecting Domo to neo4j, and adding animation to spin a "feeling wheel" that allows users to select and reflect how they're feeling in any given moment.

#### FROM BURNOUT TO BREAKTHROUGH

After launching the MVP, EIG provided a seamless transition to vellum's internal product team. What vellum and EIG built together continues to make it easier to identify distressed team members for proactive intervention, promote and encourage peer-to-peer recognition, and to instill a culture of psychological safety.
